CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT 3040 BIDDLE ROAD MEDFORD, OREGON 97504

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 3 in the QUARTZ CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 55.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11703. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 29, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 73 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW1/4 NW1/4, SECTION 9, T 35 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 920 FEET SOUTH AND 380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) and 2.5 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ 13.5 ACRES NW¼ NW¼ 22.4 ACRES SW¼ NW¼ 19.5 ACRES SE¼ NW¼ 0.5 ACRES SECTION 9

TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a

complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by PERMIT G-11302, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 2.4 2004 , approving Transfer Application 9436

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
