CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #2 in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 39.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9730. The date of priority is DECEMBER 21, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.50 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated, and is further limited to a total diversion not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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

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This certificate is issued to confirm the right NOT modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 60, Page 213, canceling a portion of the right evidenced by Certificate 64027, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
