CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAYMOND M. PORTER and SONS ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the BIG BUTTER CREEK BASIN, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 15.4 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 53.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2797. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.86 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 23, T 1 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 580 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, NE'4 SE'4, SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:
