confirms the right to use the waters of unnamed stream and North Myrtle Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for domestic use for one family and irrigation of 14.2 acres.

This right was perfected under permit S-37043. the date of priority is July 13, 1972. the amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.185 cubic feet per second, being 0.005 cfs from unnamed stream for domestic use and 0.18 cfs from North Myrtle Creek for irrigation of 14.2 acres, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
