CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HUGH H. WHITE, SHARLET SLACK, J. E. FRANKLIN, CHARLES W. BUCK, WM. E. MARTINDALE, AND MRS. ARTHUR KALLERT, BY A. BUCK, SECRETARY STAR ROUTE KERBY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of East Fork Illinois River, a tributary of Illinois River, for irrigation of 4.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 13140. The date of priority is May 16, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.081 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW1/4 SW1/4, Section 27, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW1/4 SE1/4 1.7 ACRES (WHITE)
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

NW¼ NE¼ 2.3 ACRES (FRANKLIN)
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WET, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 56495, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 1 2 2004, approving Transfer Applications 9175, 9176, 9177, 9183, 9220, 9223, 9238, 9248, 9265.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
