CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LUCIOUS ROBINSON  
KERBY, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, and ILLINOIS RIVER a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 41 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SECTION 27, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M.; KERBYVILLE MILLING AND IRRIGATION COMPANY DITCH FOR LOT 6 (SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>), SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 670 FEET NORTH AND 1560 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33 FOR TRACT 2.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76228, State Record of Water Right

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
