CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the Fort Rock Basin for IRRIGATION of 65 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10925. The date of priority is April 4, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.81 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, T 26 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 60 FEET North & 1320 FEET West of the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. Water user shall maintain a suitable measuring device, and continue to keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  32.5 ACRES  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  32.5 ACRES  
SECTION 30  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Permit G-10925 (as modified by Special Order Volume 52, Page 821) NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 11 2004, approving Transfer Application 8925.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
