CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER for the purpose of LIVESTOCK and IRRIGATION of 12.8 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, the said decree entered at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 1 at Page 449. The date of priority is 1893. This right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock use, and 0.16 CFS for irrigation from July 1<sup>st</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52182, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 28 2005, approving Transfer Application 6969.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture of abandonment.
