CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BETZ FARMS 240 E. McKINNEY AVENUE HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 105.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3895. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 13, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.33 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE¼ SE¼, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.; 200 FEET NORTH AND 540 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
