The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.

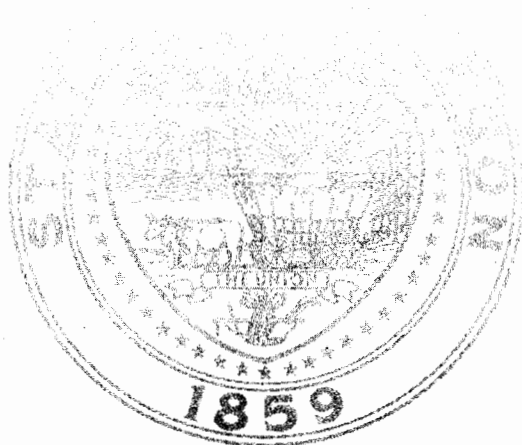
This Certificate is issued to correctly describe the county and the location of the place of use and supersedes Certificate 69240.
