CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of the SANTIAM RIVER, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12033. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 11.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, T 9 S, R 1 W, W.M..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTIONS 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15,
22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27,
28, 33, 34, 35, AND 36

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, 10, 11,
AND 12

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12033, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 01 2004, approving Transfer Application T-9192.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
