CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A. V. GILBERT 5074 MOUNTAIN FIR STREET SWEETHOME, OREGON 97386

confirms the right to use the waters of HAMILTON CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 44.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 19473. The date of priority is APRIL 25, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.556 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; NE 1/4 SW 1/4 AND NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE SE 1/4 NE 1/4 9.4 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.4 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.7 ACRE

SECTION 25

TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.
