CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J. H. WITTROCK
KERBY, OREGON 97531

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.29 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed one cubic foot per second for each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ 1.29
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 13949, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 09 2004, approving Transfer Application 9182.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
