CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 19.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25370. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.36 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: LAYCOCK-LONG DITCH or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M.; 1130 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 56303, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 09 2004, approving Transfer Application 9323.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
