CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JEDEDIAH AYLETT
76625 FRONTAGE LANE
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 58.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-190. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.725 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 28, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 90 FEET NORTH AND 40 FEET WEST FROM THE S $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:


NE¼ SW¼ 29.0 ACRES
NW¼ SW¼ 29.0 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68430, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 8901, entered AUG 11 2004.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
