CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM AND CHAROTTE NEELY
ROUTE 3, BOX 148
FREEWATER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRING BRANCH, a tributary of WALLA WALLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 19303. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.90 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, T 6 N, R 35 E, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.90 cfs.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
