## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 39.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1883 FOR 20.0 ACRES AND 1888 FOR 19.1 ACRES.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% NE%, SECTION 29, T 8 S, R 45 E, W.M. - TOBIN DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
