CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HANSELL BROTHERS, INC.
28286 STAFFORD ROAD
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 8 within the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 26.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3822. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.325 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (if available at the original point of appropriation described as Well No. 2, located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T 4 N, R 27 E. W.M.; 1420 feet North and 490 feet West from the SE corner of Section 27) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

WELL #8 - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 4 N, R 27 E, W.M.; 1160 FEET NORTH AND 370 EAST FROM W $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 26.0 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 80594, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 24 2004, approving Transfer Application 9275 and correcting a scrivener's error in the description of the location of Well #8.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
