 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOSEPH MILL WELLS #1 & #2 in the WALLOWA RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6026. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 19, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.84 cfs, being 0.54 cfs from Well #1 and 0.30 cfs from Well #2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 55036, State Record of Water Right Certificates, erroneously cancelled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 24, 2002, approving Transfer Application T-7856.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
