confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the IRRIGATION OF 54.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46560. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.88 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M.; NORTH 76 DEGREES 45 MINUTES 56 SECONDS EAST 2913.19 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 28.2 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 26.0 ACRES
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 53733, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer Application 6834, entered NOV 22 2004.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
