confirms the right to store the waters of RUNOFF, A TRIBUTARY OF HOG CANYON CREEK IN TWO RESERVOIRS for WILDLIFE.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-77425. The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and used each year under this right is not more than 5.0 ACRE-FEET

Located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST, WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE LOCATION OF THE RESERVOIRS AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 71016.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
