CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT MOREHOUSE
SILVER LAKE OR 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the CHRISTMAS LAKE VALLEY BASIN for IRRIGATION of 30.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-826. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.38 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

27 S	18 E	WM	6	SE NW	1310 FEET SOUTH AND 1120 FEET EAST OF THE NW CORNER, SECTION 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

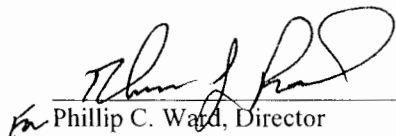
A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 33068, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEB 01 2005, approving Transfer Application 8518, and corrects the basin name.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
