CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID ROTH AND GALYN ROTH

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 6 in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 135.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6530. The date of priority is JULY 8, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.; 1340 FEET NORTH AND 3880 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	14.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4	12.7 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	38.8 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	39.8 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.0 ACRES

SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.


SECTION 12

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
