## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D.O. AND MRS. ANNA SAUNDERS MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of DRY CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for Tract #1, and SAUNDERS SPRING BRANCH, a tributary of DRY CREEK, for Tract #2, for IRRIGATION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at Page 148. The date of priority is 1880 FOR TRACT #1 AND 1895 FOR TRACT #2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed one acre foot per acre during any thirty-day period, nor three acre feet per acre during irrigation season beginning April 1<sup>st</sup> and ending October 1<sup>st</sup> or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversions are located as follows:

SAUNDERS DITCH (TRACT #1)

PRIVATE DITCH (TRACT #2).
