confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 35589. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 14, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CATCHING DLC 40, SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH AND 1600 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.1 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN CATCHING DLC 40
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
