CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON  
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of Crystal Springs Creek, a tributary of JOHNSON CREEK, to maintain instream flows for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT. The date of priority is August 13, 1965 (March 1 to October 31) and October 1, 1971 (October 31 to March 1).

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) or 4.72 acre-feet its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period March 1 to October 31 of each year and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) during the period October 31 to March 1 of each year.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

200 feet north and 1480 feet west from the NE Corner LLWELLYN DLC 49 W.M., (March 1 to October 31); 140 feet South and 210 feet west of the NE Corner, Llewellyn DLC 49 WM., (October 31 to March 1) both as projected within NE ¼ SW ¼, SECTION 13, T 1 S, R 1 E, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion in Crystal Springs Creek to the mouth of Crystal Springs Creek (River Mile One on JOHNSON Creek) in the Willamette Basin.

This certificate is issued to confirm the reduction in the rate of diversion and transfer of lands approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 2000, in Volume 54, Page 524 Special Order Records of the Water Resources Department, approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application #8 and ~~supercedes Certificates #~~ 80470, ~~Special Order Records of Water Right Certificates.~~

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows and is subject to all other terms and conditions of the original certificate, including those of the decree.
