CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the Senecal Creek BASIN for maintenance of goldfish ponds.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1012. The date of priority is September 18, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Whitney DLC 55, Section 6, T5S, R1W, W.M.; 1.5 chains north and 75 chains east from the SE corner of Whitney DLC 55.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

As projected within Whitney DLC 55
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 27867, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 25 2004, approving Transfer Application 7241 and also corrects the DLC number in the description of the point of appropriation and place of use of water.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
