CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OTTO CANTRALL
RUCH OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLGATE R, a tributary of the APPLGATE R for IRRIGATION of 180.5 ACRES and LIVESTOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Special Order Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1857. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 3.6 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 31, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 2280, 2287, 2290, 2296, and 2299, approving Transfers 8938, 8943, 8944, 8946 and 8947. This certificate confirms the change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 10, 1926 at Special Order Volume 1, Page 256 and corrects a scrivener's error in the location of the point of diversion. This certificate supercedes Certificate 16395, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

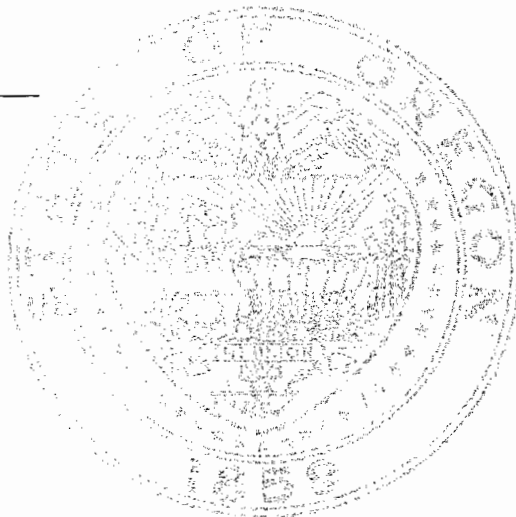
The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

Note: This Certificate conforms to a decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County dated April 19th, 1928, in conformity with Mandate of Supreme Court of Oregon ; and also conforms to an amended decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, dated November 20, 1947.
