CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK WISNOVSKY 1352 APPLEGATE RD JACKSONVILLE OR 97530 SUPERSEDED BY CERT. NO. 86834

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE APPLEGATE R, a tributary of the APPLEGATE R, for IRRIGATION of 24.70 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-36586. The date of priority is OCTOBER 27, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.31 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.50 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-380-6010 to describe the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 31, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 2280, approving Transfers 8939 and supercedes Certificate 49261, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
