CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for MAINTENANCE OF A FISH POND.

This right was perfected under Permit S-24611. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 23, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 17, T 2 N, R 13 E, W.M..

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) FISH POND
SECTION 16


TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68382, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 20 2004, approving Transfer Application 7821.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
