confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 78.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1865.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

ENTERPRISE DITCH - NW1/4 SW1/4, SECTION 20, T 13 S, R 31 E, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1 acre-foot per calendar month to July 1; and ¾ acre-foot per acre thereafter; total 5.0 acre-feet per acre for the season, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
