confirms the right to use the waters of an unnamed spring creek (Jackass Creek), a tributary of the Rogue River, for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6715. The date of priority is APRIL 24, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the original point of diversion, SW% SE%, SECTION 10, T 6 S, R 8 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

The authorized point of diversion is located as follows:

SW% SE%, SECTION 10, T 6 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 55 FEET NORTH AND 520 FEET EAST FROM THE S% CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE% SE% 3.0 ACRES SECTION 10

TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the following additional conditions:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Prior to October 1, 2006, the water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction, and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife. The water user may participate in the Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost-sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.
