CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENNIS K. AND KATHLEEN G. COOPER

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 7.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1876.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 33, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1250 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 7.3 ACRES
SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the authorized quantity of water diverted and describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 79835, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 1, 2004, approving Transfer Application 8589, and supersedes Certificate 80938.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
