confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BEAVER CREEK, a tributary of GALES CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 1.5 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit S-26029. The date of priority is MARCH 5, 1959. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.024 CUBIC FOOT FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% NE%, SECTION 25, T 2 N, R 5 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
