CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of J. W. BARNEY RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-4890, a tributary of TRASK RIVER, for POLLUTION ABATEMENT WITHIN THE TUALATIN RIVER CHANNEL.

This right was perfected under Permit 35782. The date of priority is JULY 8, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 30.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the point of discharge into the Tualatin River located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 22, Township 1 South, Range 6 West, W.M. downstream to the confluence with the Willamette River located within the SW 1/4, Section 2, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

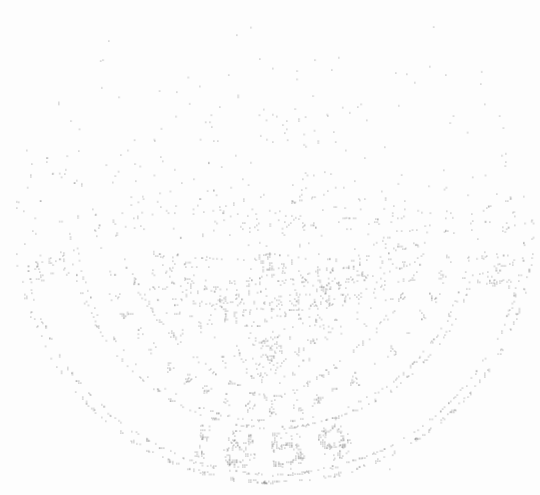
