confirms the right to store the waters of MIDDLE FORK OF THE NORTH FORK OF THE TRASK RIVER, a tributary of TRASK RIVER, in J. W. BARNEY RESERVOIR, appropriated under Permit 35782, for POLLUTION ABATEMENT.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-5773. The date of priority is December 23, 1971. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 2000 ACRE-FEET (AF).



The amount of water allowed to be stored under this right, together with the amount allowed under Permit R-4890 is limited to 20,000 AF.

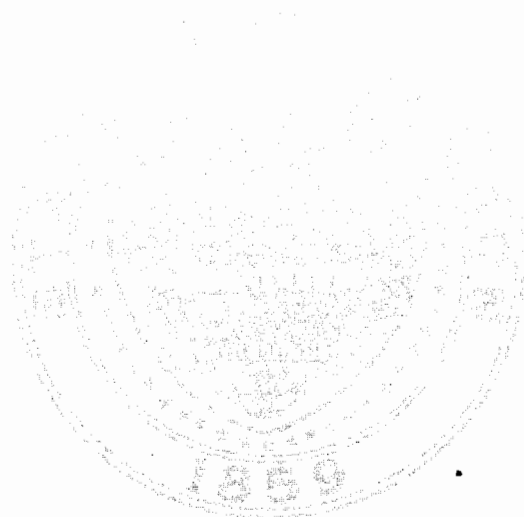
The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
