CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 26.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 7361. The date of priority is MAY 26, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.174 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
