## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM AND FLORENCE HOWELL P.O. BOX 151 IMBLER, OREGON 97841

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER AND OLD CHANNEL GRANDE RONDE RIVER RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7844, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 167.4 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 44320. The date of priority is JUNE 15, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ NW¾, SECTION 28, T 1 S, R 39 E, W.M.; 720 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST; PUMP LOCATED - 1380 FEET SOUTH AND 1600 FEET EAST BOTH FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
