CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON BERRY PACKING COMPANY
ROUTE 6 BOX 232
HILLSBORO, OREGON 97123

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the CHRISTENSEN CREEK BASIN for the purpose of MAINTENANCE OF LRM RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER RESERVOIR PERMIT NO. R-6128 FOR FISH CULTURE.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-8144. The date of priority is MARCH 10, 1977. This right is limited to 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN C. LEWIS DLC 51, SECTION 31,
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; 450 FEET SOUTH AND 2650 FEET
EAST FROM NW CORNER OF SECTION 31.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN C. LEWIS DLC 51
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

In the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
