CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTERS OF OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of ALLEN CREEK RESERVOIR  
CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1710, a tributary of NORTH FORK CROOKED  
RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 1154.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23392. The date of priority is  
JANUARY 31, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled  
is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not  
exceed 364.3 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of  
rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

ALLEN CREEK DAM DIVERSION - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 14  
SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 970 FEET NORTH AND 480 FEET WEST FROM THE  
SE CORNER OF SECTION 2;

ALLEN CREEK RE-DIVERSION - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 14  
SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 1120 FEET SOUTH AND 210 FEET WEST FROM THE  
NE CORNER OF SECTION 11;

GILL DITCH RE-DIVERSION - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 14  
SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 4530 FEET SOUTH AND 1560 FEET WEST FROM  
THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 11; AND

MERRITT DITCH RE-DIVERSION - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 14  
SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 1840 FEET SOUTH AND 2950 FEET WEST FROM  
THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount  
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre  
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow  
and storage.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is  
subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for  
judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of  
the date of service.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



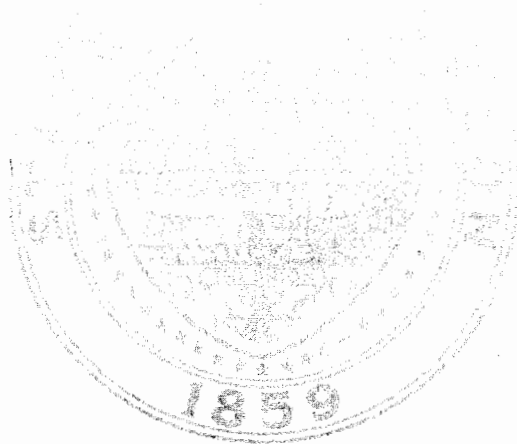
SECTION 15
