## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LES SCHWAB TIRE CENTERS OF OREGON P.O. BOX 667 PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of PETERSON CREEK AND PETERSON CREEK AND PETERSON CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1554, a tributary of NORTH FORK CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 23.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 214.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22573. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM DIRECT FLOW FOR PRIMARY IRRIGATION AND 93.5 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY FOR PRIMARY AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

RESERVOIR - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 130 FEET NORTH AND 680 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 12; AND

PETERSON CREEK AND RE-DIVERSION - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 80 FEET SOUTH AND 960 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 13; AND

PETERSON CREEK AND RE-DIVERSION - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 1700 FEET NORTH AND 1550 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
