CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BAKER ROCK CRUSHING, INC.
21880 SW FARMINGTON ROAD
BEAVERTON, OREGON 97007

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for WASHING ROCK.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1985. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 9, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.2593 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 275 FEET NORTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF THE SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate corrects a scrivener's error in the priority date and describes that portion of the water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 4, 2004, approving Transfer Application 8853, and supersedes Certificate 80732.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
