## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C. R. YUNKER WHEELER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of THE CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 43.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23903. The date of priority is November 4, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.09 cubic feet per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
