CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOSEPH RAMOS
ECHO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.65 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 6179. The date of priority is January 21, 1924. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second (cfs), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 7536, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 16, 1998, and recorded in Special Order Volume 52, Page 26, approving Transfer Application 7577.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
