CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL KRAEMER
13523 MARQUAM ROAD NE
MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of ABIQUA CREEK, a tributary of the PUDDING RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 21.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22241. The date of priority is APRIL 8, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN ALLEN DLC 50, SECTION 24,
T 6 S, R 1 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 5.4 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 7.2 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.8 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.6 ACRES
SECTION 24
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN ALLEN DLC 50
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 22396, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 13 2005, approving Transfer Application 8196.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
