### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Althouse Creek, a tributary of Illinois River, for IRRIGATION of 143.68 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 427. The date of priority is 1856 for 94.10 acres and 1870 for 49.58 acres.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 2.87 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs), being 0.99 cfs through the Morey Ditch, if available at the original point of diversion, the Houck and George ditch, and 1.88 cfs through the Houck and George Ditch.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Morey Ditch - located in NE ¼, NW ¼, Section 18, T40S, R7W, W.M.
860 feet South and 2090 feet East from the NW corner of Sec. 18

Houck and George Ditch - located in the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8, T40S, R7W, W.M. 180 feet South and 1180 feet East from the West  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 8.
