CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A.S. Kleinhammer
Buncom, Oregon

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Applegate River, a tributary of Applegate River for irrigation of 97.7 acres, domestic and stock use.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is September 1, 1857 for 1.90 cfs for irrigation of 75.7 acres; 1898 for 0.55 cfs for irrigation of 22 acres domestic and stock use.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 2.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE ¼ NW ¼, Section 29, T39S, R2W, WM.
