## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is recorded at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINERS INCHES per acre measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
