 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED DRAINAGE DITCH, a tributary of DAIRY CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 32.5 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 3.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-28373. The date of priority is AUGUST 22, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.40 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.05 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

1 N	4 W	WM	23	NE NE	380 FEET SOUTH AND 820 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm the right modified by provisions of an order recorded at Special Order Volume 63, Page 409, diminishing the right evidenced by Certificate 34828. This certificate supersedes Certificate 34828.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
