CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WELDON WANKIER
67405 HARRINGTON LOOP RD
BEND, OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 28.3 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is NOVEMBER, 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.566 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

PLAINVIEW DITCH - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 710 FEET NORTH AND 2640 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.



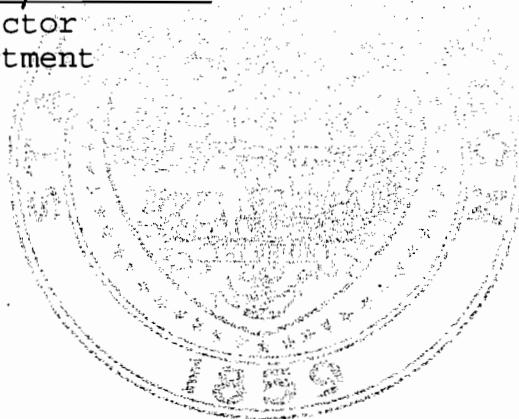
